

MINIMUM WORKING ACTIVITIES FOR SOLAR (LAND-BASED) PROJECT UNDER CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY (COA)	
YEAR 1	
1	Local Government Units (LGUs) Resolution of Support – at least two (2) resolutions of support (Barangay and Municipality; or Barangay and Provincial)
2	National Commission for Indigenous Peoples (NCIP)
3	Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR)
4	Department of Agriculture (DA)
5	National Grid Corporation of the Philippines (NGCP)

Criteria for the evaluation of compliance with the COA accomplishments:

- a. Submit at least proof of application with above NGAs and LGUs before the date of evaluation of compliance (see deadline at item "C" below).
- b. The above requirements are mandatory and RE Developers shall justify if the permit is not applicable.
- c. Deadline of compliance with the COA: on or before the 9th month (for Land-based) and the 1st year (for Floating) from the issuance of COA.
- d. Submission of Annual Report and updated Work Program at least one month before the end of COA.

Applicability:

- ***if the PV panels are mounted on HDPE pontoons, then the scheme of development is considered floating solar
- ***if the PV panels are mounted on a fixed-bottom structure, then the scheme of development is considered land-based
